East

Bonneville Interagency Council

- **Schedule:** Meets quarterly
- **Format and Location:** Meetings are held in person in Idaho Falls
- **Description:** A collaborative gathering of nonprofits and government human services agencies working together to strengthen communication, build partnerships, and better support Bonneville County and surrounding areas.

Idaho Falls Nonprofit Alliance (IFNPA)

- **Schedule:** Meets the first Friday of each month
- **Format and Location:** Meetings are held at various changing locations in Idaho Falls. There is a virtual option if needed.
- **Description:** Local nonprofits gather to discuss current challenges, share organizational updates, and coordinate on upcoming events. Some meetings may also feature a guest speaker for a portion of the hour.

Madison Interagency Council

- **Schedule:** Meets quarterly
- **Format and Location:** Meetings are held in person in Rexburg
- **Description:** A collaborative gathering of nonprofits and government human services agencies working together to strengthen communication, build partnerships, and better support the Upper Snake River Valley community. Includes Jefferson, Madison, and Fremont counties.

Southeastern Idaho Nonprofit Connection (SEINC)

- **Schedule:** Meets the second Thursday of each month

- **Format and Location:** Meetings are held at various changing locations in Pocatello. There is a virtual option if needed.
- **Description:** Local nonprofits gather to discuss current challenges, share organizational updates, and coordinate on upcoming events. Some meetings may also feature a guest speaker for a portion of the hour.

North

CDA Regional Chamber Nonprofit Committee

- **Schedule:** Meets the third Wednesday of each month
- **Format and Location:** CDA Chamber members only. Non-Chamber members may attend once as guests. Meetings are held in person. There is a virtual option if needed.
- **Description:** Addresses the opportunities and challenges faced by nonprofit organizations in Kootenai County.

Kootenai County Nonprofit Group

- **Schedule:** Meets the third Friday of each month
- **Format and Location:** Meetings are held at a consistent, centrally located meeting space, in Coeur d'Alene. There is a virtual option if needed.
- **Description:** Local nonprofits gather to discuss current challenges, share organizational updates, and coordinate on upcoming events. Some meetings may also feature a guest speaker for a portion of the hour.

Lewiston Area

- **Schedule:** Meets the first Tuesday of each month
- **Format and Location:** Meetings are held in person
- **Description:** Local nonprofits gather to discuss current challenges, share organizational updates, and coordinate on upcoming events. Some meetings may also feature a guest speaker for a portion of the hour.

Moscow Nonprofit Alliance (NPA)

a Program of the Moscow Chamber of Commerce + Visitors Center

- **Schedule:** Meets the second Monday of each month
- **Format and Location:** Meetings are held at the Moscow Chamber of Commerce, in person. Non-Chamber members are welcome to attend and share announcements during the first 10 minutes, the remaining time is dedicated to members only.

- **Description:** The NPA is a standing committee of the MCOC+VC. Local nonprofits gather to remain closely connected with the broader business community, amplify their voices on community-wide issues, and streamline collaboration and communication. Most importantly, it ensures nonprofit organizations have a dedicated space to plan, problem solve, and celebrate the vital role they play in our community.

Post Falls Regional Chamber Nonprofit Committee

- **Schedule:** Meets the first Thursday of each month
- **Format and Location:** Post Falls Chamber members only. Meetings are held in person. There is a virtual option if needed.
- **Description:** Addresses the opportunities and challenges faced by nonprofit organizations in Post Falls.

Sandpoint Nonprofit Executive Director Collab

- **Schedule:** Meets the second Friday of each month
- **Format and Location:** Meetings are held at a consistent, centrally located meeting space, in Sandpoint. There is a virtual option if needed.
- **Description:** Local nonprofits meet to strengthen community collaboration and support one another through shared challenges. The gatherings also build executive director leadership through peer learning, coordinated planning, and occasional guest insights.

Boise Nonprofit Development Professionals

- **Schedule:** Typically meets every other month. Exact dates vary.
- **Format and Location:** Meetings are held at nonprofit locations across the Treasure Valley. Members of the group trade off hosting in person.
- **Description:** A casual group of fundraisers gathering to connect and share resources. Discussions focus on nonprofit fundraising related topics and lead by rotating members.

- **Format and Location:** Boise Metro Chamber of Commerce members only. Meetings are held in person.
