

Bonner County Fund for Arts Enhancement Grant Cycle Guidelines

Deadline: May 1

Anticipated Award Notification Date: June

Applications Reviewed By: Bonner County based review committee.

<u>Grant Range:</u> Awards typically range from \$3,000 - \$12,000.

About the Bonner County Fund for Arts Enhancement

The Bonner County Fund for Arts Enhancement was created to enhance the arts in Bonner County by providing funds either to develop a community education component of existing arts programs or to help fund new arts programs whose major emphasis includes a strong educational focus.

Eligibility for Funding Consideration

Organizations and entities located in Bonner County (or serving the Bonner County community) that meet one of the three following criteria:

- Organizations with a 501(c)(3) public charity status under IRS code 170
- Public educational institutions
- Government entities including local governments and libraries

Favored and Less Favored Activities

The advisors to the Fund will consider grant requests for activities and projects that:

- Reach a broad segment of the community or school population
- Focus on providing information, education, and programs designed to increase awareness of the importance of understanding the arts as an integral part of a vital community
- Celebrate the value of artistic diversity for the quality of life in Bonner County

Projects will be **<u>favored</u>** if they include the following features:

- Collaboration with other community groups
- Provision of matching or in-kind funds
- Project sustainability
- Meeting an urgent or ongoing community need
- Adding an educational component to existing arts programs
- Letters indicating community support

Less favored projects include:

- Capital projects
- Travel for individuals
- Attendance at conferences

Projects ineligible for funding include:

- Projects that benefit a private individual
- Fundraising projects
- Political activities or those designed to influence legislation
- Religious organizations for the sole purpose of furthering that religion
- Grants to individuals

Application Process:

To apply, <u>login to your ICF portal account</u> and click on Opportunities.

Grant Reporting:

If awarded a grant, the grant period is just under one year, with an End of Grant Report due on May 1st following the year you were awarded.
