Starting June 1 through July 30, Idahoans age 18 and older can enter at idahocf.org/make-more-good-possible.php. One winner from each of ICF's four regions – East, North, South Central, and Southwest – will be selected at random to direct a \$5,000+ grant to a local nonprofit doing essential work in their area.

Idahoans can also donate directly to the prize pool or to their regional Forever Idaho Fund to increase the impact of local philanthropy and help ensure communities have access to the services they need—now and in the future.
