# \$200M Moment Campaign Heats Up: Prize Pool Doubles to \$40,000 to Support Idaho Nonprofits

**IDAHO** – The Idaho Community Foundation is thrilled to announce that the prize pool for its **\$200M Moment campaign** has **doubled from \$20,000 to \$40,000**, thanks to contributions from generous Idahoans who believe in the power of community giving.

Now, four lucky Idahoans—one from each region of the state—will get the opportunity to award a **\$10,000 grant** to a **promising nonprofit** in their community. That's right: **\$10,000 per region** to support the organizations that care for our communities every day.

"A \$10,000 grant can be truly transformational for a smaller nonprofit," said Steve Burns, President and CEO of The Idaho Community Foundation. "This campaign is about celebrating what makes Idaho special—neighbors helping neighbors—and showing what we can accomplish when we come together."

Idaho residents age 18 and older can enter the contest online until **12 p.m. (noon) MT** on **Wednesday, July 30**. No donation is required to enter.

On **July 31**, Governor **Brad Little** will help draw the four winners at the Idaho State Capitol. Each winner will choose a qualifying nonprofit in their region to receive the \$10,000 grant and community celebration events will be held in mid-August in each grantee community.
