Idaho Community Foundation to Host Celebration in Boise Honoring \$200M Milestone and Local Grant Recipient

Boise — The Idaho Community Foundation (ICF) is hitting the road to celebrate a milestone \$200 million granted to Idaho communities since 1988. One of its statewide celebration stops will be Boise, where Boise Bicycle Project was selected through ICF's "\$200M Moment" campaign to receive a \$10,000 grant.

The celebration will take place Tuesday, August 19, from 4–6 p.m. at Lost Grove Brewing, located at 1026 S. La Pointe St., Boise. The event is free and open to the public, with refreshments, a short program, and opportunities to share community stories on video.

"This is more than a grant, it's a celebration of what makes Idaho special: neighbors supporting neighbors," said **Walt Sinclair**, Board Chair for ICF. "We're honored to recognize Boise Bicycle Project and the powerful way they're creating connection, opportunity, and community through bicycles."

Boise Bicycle Project (BBP) is a nonprofit bicycle cooperative that believes access to bicycles can transform lives. BBP provides bicycle repair, education, and advocacy programs for children, adults, and families, especially those from underserved communities. Each year, they put thousands of Idahoans on two wheels and into a supportive network that values self-reliance, sustainability, and inclusion.

The grant was awarded through a public campaign that invited Idahoans to enter for a chance to direct a \$10,000 grant to a nonprofit in their community. More than



2,200 people participated, and winners from each of ICF's four regions were drawn at the Idaho State Capitol on July 31 with Governor Brad Little.

Gilbert Moreno of Ada County, the Southwest Region winner, selected Boise Bicycle Project, sharing:

"Boise Bicycle Project is committed to helping everyone in our community to experience the joy and freedom that bicycling can provide. I am so happy to support their vision with this grant and hope it will help them continue to provide the great work they do!"
