Chobani Community Impact Fund Grant Application Due November 17

Twin Falls – Since its founding in 2018, the **Chobani Community Impact Fund in The Idaho Community Foundation** has granted more than **\$1 million** to strengthen communities across the Magic Valley. Focused on combating food and nutrition insecurity, the fund supports local programs that ensure families in Twin Falls and Jerome counties have access to healthy meals, nutrition education, and vital hunger-fighting resources.

What:

The Chobani Community Impact Fund, in partnership with The Idaho Community Foundation, is accepting applications for grants totaling **\$100,000** to support organizations working to address **food and nutrition insecurity** in Twin Falls and Jerome counties. Typical grants will range from \$5,000–\$20,000.

Who Can Apply:

- Nonprofits with 501(c)(3) status
- Government agencies or departments (including schools)
- Organizations based in or serving Twin Falls and/or Jerome counties

When:

The application deadline is **Sunday, November 17, 2025, at 11:59 p.m. MST**. Award announcements will be made in **December 2025**.
