Idaho Community Foundation awards \$228K+ in south central Idaho

The Idaho Community Foundation is awarding more than \$228,000 in support to 48 organizations in the Magic Valley and Wood River Valley from its Forever Idaho South Central program – including domestic violence programs, senior centers, libraries and more.

Grantees are from Blaine, Camas, Cassia, Elmore, Gooding, Jerome, Lincoln, Minidoka and Twin Falls counties. One of the unique aspects of Forever Idaho grants is that they are flexible and can be used for the recipients' greatest needs.

"Our nonprofit partners consistently tell us that their greatest need is unrestricted funding," said Lisa Bearg, ICF's senior philanthropic advisor. "We're proud of Forever Idaho's hyper-local approach, and the flexibility it provides to these organizations so they can serve the community in the most effective way."
