In the 20 years since ICF began its grant making activities, it has strived to enrich the quality of life through Idaho. Thanks to our generous members, fund creators, donors and other supporters we have touched thousands of people over two decades.

This Annual Report details the activities of the past year. As you'll see in the President's Letter we made nearly **800 grants** totaling more than **\$4.8 million**. We have more than **825 members** and nearly **1,000 donors**.

Also in this Annual Report are stories from the Idaho Youth Ranch (IYR) and other grant recipients. IYR has received grants from Idaho Community Foundation funds since 1993, making it one of the longest running and most consistent recipients since ICF first began granting in 1991. IYR has received more than \$117,000 since 1993, and more than \$62,000 since 2005.

"We feel very fortunate that for nearly 20 years and through many of its contributors, ICF has partnered with our agency to provide Idaho's troubled and at-risk children the courage, hope, knowledge, skills and will to succeed," said IYR President Steve Woodworth. "We are grateful for the investment they have made in Idaho's future."

## Dear Friends of the Idaho Community Foundation,



The most recent edition of **Trends in Northwest Giving**, released in early spring by Philanthropy Northwest ([www.philanthropyNW.org](http://www.philanthropyNW.org)), shows giving in Idaho increased more than 200 percent between 2004 and 2008 (the most recent year for which data was analyzed).

According to the report:

Total giving to Idaho from 109 foundations: **\$133,917,778**

Number of grants: **1,105**

Median grant: **\$8,500**

Increase between 2004 and 2008: **239%**

This is quite impressive especially given the economic downturn that Idaho and the rest of the country began experiencing in 2007. It reinforces my belief that Idahoans are deeply generous and philanthropic. It will be interesting to view the data for 2008 through 2011 some years from now.

The report goes on to say that **ICF was the third largest funder to nonprofits in Idaho in 2008**. This is something for which all of us should be tremendously proud, especially considering the top two funders to Idaho nonprofits were the J.A. and Kathryn Albertson Foundation and the Micron Foundation. **Your memberships, gifts and funds at ICF are making an enormous difference in the lives of those who need your help.**

After a very successful 2010, ICF has its own good news to share, which you will find detailed in this Annual Report:

- The **2010 endowment portfolio increased almost 17 percent** and brought the endowment to its second highest level ever. That follows an increase of nearly 27 percent during 2009.
- The portfolio increase **beat the ICF endowment benchmark by 1.7 percent** and was also 1.7 percent above the S&P 500 year-ending mark.
- ICF provided **more than \$4.8 million in grants, distributions and scholarships in 2010**. Since the first distributions began in 1991, ICF has granted and distributed **more than \$53 million across Idaho**.

- Endowment contributions were **more than \$5 million** (the second highest ever) and when combined with non-endowment contributions **were over \$9.5 million** (the third highest ever).


- ICF assets closed 2010 at an all-time high.

- ICF has more funds now than any time in its history.

To what do we attribute all this positive news? Clearly the revitalization of the commodities market is so very significant – not only for the increase in the ICF endowment but also in the changed psychology for all of us. It is a sign of hope that we are emerging from the Great Recession.

I also commend the hard work of the **ICF Board of Directors and staff** these past several years and of course the generous and committed **ICF fund creators, members and donors**. We believe ICF's increased visibility across the state – including our regional offices, extensive travel, frequent presentations to service groups and financial planning specialists, and visits to current funders and potential donors – has helped spread the word about us. We had **more than 1,000 people attend various ICF events last year**, including our newly-expanded Annual Luncheon and Regional Luncheons. I sincerely thank all of you for your involvement with and participation in ICF.

In my travels across the state, I often visit ICF fund creators and nonprofit grant recipients. I continue to be both amazed and impressed by their extraordinary passion and marvelous leadership. **ICF connects funders to hundreds of charitable organizations** throughout Idaho to support their crucial work of helping families, advancing the arts, providing for low-income children and seniors, and enhancing the work of teachers, schools, students and more. That is the great significance of our organization and I am so proud to be part of it.

## ICF Financials for 2010

The Idaho Community Foundation invests for the long term in accord with a written policy on investments and distributions. The Foundation's current asset allocation target for the endowment is **55% domestic equities, 25% international equities, and 20% domestic fixed income securities**. Non-endowed, fully expendable funds (including philanthropic gift funds and special project funds) are invested in liquid money market instruments. The Foundation does not invest in derivatives and does not make investments which have restrictions on liquidity. Like most long-term investors, ICF believes in accepting the risks inherent in investing in equities in order to benefit from the long-term rewards which usually result from such an investment strategy.

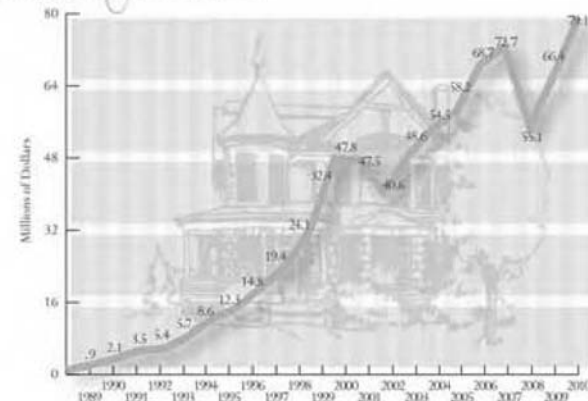

(1) Land for resale includes two non-cash contributions of property donated to the Foundation. The Foundation intends to sell the land and place the proceeds in specific funds according to the donation agreements. The value of the land recorded as an asset is equivalent to the county-assessed values for 2010.

(2) The Foundation accounts for its funds held as agency endowments in accordance with FASB Accounting Standards Codification Topic ASC 958 (previously Statement of Financial Accounting Standards No. 136). ASC 958 specifically requires that if a Not-For-Profit Organization (NPO) accepts cash or other financial assets from a donor, agrees to use those assets on behalf of or transfer those assets to establish a fund at a community foundation, and specifies itself as the beneficiary of that fund, the community foundation must account for the transfer of such asset as a liability. For financial reporting purposes, distributions from agency endowments in the amounts of \$299,249 in 2010 and \$320,100 in 2009 are not included in the reported Grants and Distributions of the Foundation.

(3) Represents outstanding pledges less reserves.

(4) Includes investment management fees of \$79,193 in 2010 and \$65,404 in 2009.

"The goal of SAS! is to provide hands-on experiences that complement, extend and apply the knowledge students gain in the classroom," said Lisa Huttlinger, ERC education director. "It also provides after-school supervision that is critical to so many working parents."

ICF's Greatest Need grant cycle provided \$1,000 to SAS! for the 2010-11 school year. Grants like this are crucial because one of the important aspects of the program is that it's free, Huttlinger said.

"One in three students in the Blaine County School District qualifies for free or reduced lunch," she said. "We could charge for the program, but we believe that would discriminate against a large number of children who can greatly benefit from it."

The Idaho Youth Ranch is one of the Idaho Community Foundation's longest running and most consistent grant recipients. Below and throughout this Annual Report are profiles of people who have benefited from IYR programs.

Idaho Youth Ranch Profile:

*Kim Mora, age 26*

Kim was 16 when she was sent by her parents to the Ranch in southern Idaho's Rupert after a suicide attempt. They knew she had been hanging around with friends of whom they didn't approve, and had been increasingly despondent and uncommunicative. What they didn't know is that she had been violently raped a few months before and had started cutting herself as a way to cope with it. The more they tried to persuade her to talk to them, the more she withdrew.

Though she ran away when her parents first told her they were taking her to Rupert, she now says the Ranch, its staff and the support she received when she returned home literally saved her life.

"My parents and I call them our miracle," said Kim, who graduated from Boise State with honors in 2010 and now works at Scentsy's corporate headquarters in Meridian.

Kim spent six months at the Ranch, a short period of time considering the dramatic turnaround she experienced. She said the unique aspects of the program, including peer-led discussions, living with other girls and raising livestock (in her case a pig named Cinnamon Bernard Dean) all contributed to her ability to get back on track.

"It makes you look at yourself and it forced me to deal with what was going on inside me, but then it bubbles out to include the rest of your family," she said. "The skills that I learned helped me continue with my life and continue to heal."

She completed her high school coursework at

the Ranch and returned home to Boise. Shortly after that she met the man who would become her husband and they married a year and a half later when she was 18.

Kim entered BSU's communications and journalism program in 2003, again with the help of the Idaho Youth Ranch, which provided a scholarship for tuition and books.

When NBC's Today Show came to Boise in 2008 to film a segment about IYR, Kim attended the taping and met one of the show's producers, who persuaded her to apply for a Today Show internship. She was successful and spent five months in New York City in 2009, an opportunity she credits in part to her relationship with IYR.

"The Youth Ranch, my parents and my husband always have my back and believe in me," she said. "I look at this life I have and what I would have missed if the Youth Ranch hadn't been there for me and my family."

Idaho Youth Ranch Profile:

*Tosch Keshian, age 59*



Tosch Keshian

Tosch Keshian spent four years at the Ranch from 1974-77 when he was between the ages of 11 and 15. His father wasn't part of his life and his mother "had her own demons she was dealing with," he recalls. He was living in Ketchikan and Hailley, moving between his mother's home and foster homes when the state intervened and sent him to the Ranch.

Now 33 years later, Tosch lives with his wife Cheryl on 20 acres of property between Star and Eagle, boarding and breeding nearly 50 horses. He said his time at the Ranch gave him the opportunity to, in borsening terms, "outgrow his pedigree," meaning to exceed the expectations others had for him and that he had for himself.

"The structure we had was more than I'd had before. There were rules and if we didn't abide by them there were consequences," he said. "They also really pushed education and taught us self-discipline."

Tosch said the physical work of being at the Ranch and the responsibility of caring for animals helped him develop goals for himself. After leaving the Ranch he went to work for a man named Paul Girdner at Southwest Hide. "That was some of the hardest work I've ever done," he said.

He worked with several ex-convicts at Southwest Hide and though he never had trouble with them, he also realized it was a path he'd like to avoid.

"I don't have any idea where I would have ended up if not for the Youth Ranch and Mr. Girdner," he said. "Between them I learned how to get dropped into a situation, make it work for myself and move on."

### Idaho Youth Ranch Profile:

## Ron Ashley, age 67

Ron Ashley grew up in Boise in the late 1940s and early 50s. His mother was widowed when he was 2 and had to work to support the family. Ron recalls he had very little discipline as an adolescent.

"We were stealing gas, breaking windows, skipping school," he said. "It was nothing serious."

It was still enough to get him sent to military school in Portland where he encountered bigger, older boys who were more than mischievous petty criminals. He ran away after only two weeks and hitchhiked back to Boise. When he arrived, his mother called his probation officer and Ron was taken to jail.

He'd been in jail about a week when Idaho Youth Ranch founder Rev. James Crowe paid him a visit at the request of Ron's grandmother. Crowe and Ron spoke for a while and Crowe invited him to come out to

the Ranch and Ron accepted. He was one of the first boys accepted at the Ranch and was the first to graduate.

"When I got there they asked if I wanted to go to school," Ron said. "I didn't know I had a choice. So I said no and they put me to work plowing fields and bucking hay. In the fall they asked me again if I wanted to go to school. After that summer of hauling hay, I couldn't get to school fast enough."

The physical labor, the big, family-style meals and the education gave him the confidence he'd been lacking. After two years at the Ranch, he returned home to Boise and graduated from Borah High School. He worked as a welder's assistant and enrolled at Boise Junior College (now Boise State). He and his wife Delores married in June 1964 and had two boys.

Ron was a sales rep for several companies in the 1960s and 70s and was also a drag racer who set three national records in three classes in two years. In 1976 he opened

Ashley Glass, a highly successful company that one of his sons runs today. His other son runs Ashley Heating & Air.

Ron has stayed involved with the Idaho Youth Ranch, including serving on its board of directors for 10 years. He said he is glad to see that the programs have evolved to address the needs of youth today.

"They have complex problems and they have to have complex cures," he said. "Half the problem is the family and the other half is the kids, and (IYR) works with both sides now. They've kept up with the times to give the most benefit to the kids."

### Idaho Youth Ranch Profile

*Del Morgan, age 14*

Del Morgan was placed in foster care at age 12 because his alcoholic, abusive mother could no longer care for him. He was a chronic runaway who bounced between group homes and foster homes until he was finally deemed "out-of-control" by the juvenile corrections system and was sent to the Ranch, from which he also ran away.

After a short time at the Hays Shelter Home, which was not operated by IYR at the time, he ended up back at the Ranch and decided he was ready to change. "I was scared and unsure, but I was worried if I didn't take it seriously it was going to be end of me as a kid."

Deciding to take the Ranch program seriously didn't mean the end of rebellious behavior, however. He said the real turning point for him came when he was in a rage against one of the Youth Ranch adults. The staffer grasped him in a bear hug and spoke to him reassuringly about how he could support Del and help him make the changes he wanted.

"That's what finally got through to me. He was the first adult who wasn't going to lie to me and let me down," Del said. "There had been no adults in my life who were protective of me. To have someone show they cared and kept their word was huge."

Del said the whole staff at the Ranch took an active role in "parenting" the kids who were there. Del stayed 13 months and was a sponsored honors student when he left.

He ended up at what was then a brand-new IYR program called Emancipation House, where emancipated minors could learn life skills like cooking, financial management and job-seeking skills. Emancipation House closed in fall 2009 due to a lack of funding.

Del joined the Army at age 17 and later had careers in law enforcement, as a chef and a restaurant manager. He's been married for 13 years and has a 20-year-old daughter from his first marriage and 12-year-old twins.

He stayed involved with IYR, speaking on its behalf and participating in other ways. When a job as IYR e-commerce manager came open almost three years ago, he applied immediately even

though it meant a significant pay cut and a 70-mile round trip commute from his home in Notsus to IYR's Boise offices.

"For me it's all about doing all I can for the mission of the Ranch. I'm lucky to have had such a long relationship with the Ranch and to have watched the development of the program," he said. "It's an honor to talk to the kids who are in the programs now. If one of them benefits from a single thing I've said it's worth it."
