About ICF

Community foundations are tax-exempt public charities serving thousands of people who share a common goal – improving the quality of life in their area. Individuals, families, businesses and organizations create charitable funds that help their region meet the challenges of changing times. The community foundation invests and administers these funds. All community foundations are overseen by a volunteer board of leading citizens and are run by professionals with expertise in their community’s needs.

The Idaho Community Foundation was founded in 1988. The trustees of the Caldwell-based Whittenberger Foundation, which was overwhelmed with requests for charitable grants, approached chairman and CEO of Boise Cascade John Fery to chair a steering committee to look at the possibility of establishing a community foundation.

With support from the state’s most prominent and charitable families and individuals, and guidance from community leaders, ICF surpassed its \$20 million asset goal more than 10 years early and decided to strive for a goal of \$50 million in assets by 2000. **For 2011, ICF’s assets were \$86.2 million.**

The first ever ICF grant awards were given in 1991 – eight in the north, nine in the east and 14 in the southwest. **In 2011, ICF provided more than 1,600 grants totaling over \$4.4 million.**

ICF sincerely thanks you for all you’ve done to help us enrich the quality of life throughout Idaho.

From the CEO

Dear Friends of the Idaho Community Foundation,

As I prepared this letter, I spent some time reflecting on 2011. I don't need to remind you (and would rather not think of it myself) that the last quarter of the year was brutal for those of us invested in the stock market, whether personally or

professionally. And in many ways it tainted an otherwise very good year for ICF.

2012 has started well for ICF, aided by improvements in the stock market. At the end of the first quarter, our endowment reached \$70 million for the first time.

Our generous donors established **26 new funds** in 2011 – the most new funds since 2006 and 2000, our previous record years. In addition, new and current donors added **\$14.1 million** to existing ICF funds (\$7.3 million in endowed funds and \$6.8 million in non-endowed). Obviously this comes at a time when Idaho's nonprofits really need continued financial support to continue to weather the fourth year of the Great Recession.

Idaho nonprofits count on distributions from ICF's nearly 450 funds as one of their most reliable sources of funding and we are proud of this distinction. **We distributed close to \$4.5 million in 2011** through our three Regional Grant Cycles, 50 agency funds, 38 designated funds, 82 donor advised funds, 27 operating funds, 76 philanthropic gift funds, 68 scholarships funds and 20 special project funds.

We receive letters, notes and photos every month from nonprofits who have received a distribution from ICF. This was one of our favorites in 2011:

"The Idaho Community Foundation grant and Kissler Family Foundation donation was like a Christmas present. Personally, I did not think we had a chance (to receive a grant) and when

*we received the notice it **nearly knocked me out of my chair.** It allowed us to have a regional impact. It allowed us to give back to the people who have supported us."* – Nick Albers, Team Leader, Back Country Medics (Orofino)

Donors at all levels can work together to have the kind of impact that nearly knocks someone out of their chair.

- A greatest need fund and ICF operating fund can be started with \$5,000, which can be pledged over five years.
- A philanthropic gift fund can be started with \$5,000.
- A field of interest, donor advised, or designated fund can be started with \$25,000, which can be pledged over five years.
- A scholarship can be established for \$50,000, which can be pledged over five years.

We look forward to sharing more news with you about some exciting new initiatives in the months ahead. If you've resolved in 2012 to do more to help Idahoans in need, come talk to us. You don't need to be wealthy to make a difference and you'll always receive the maximum tax deduction. ICF offers several tax-exempt estate planning options including bequests, life insurance and more to ensure that your favorite nonprofits, causes or community will always receive your support.

As always, we at ICF are grateful for your support and we look forward to seeing what's ahead of us!

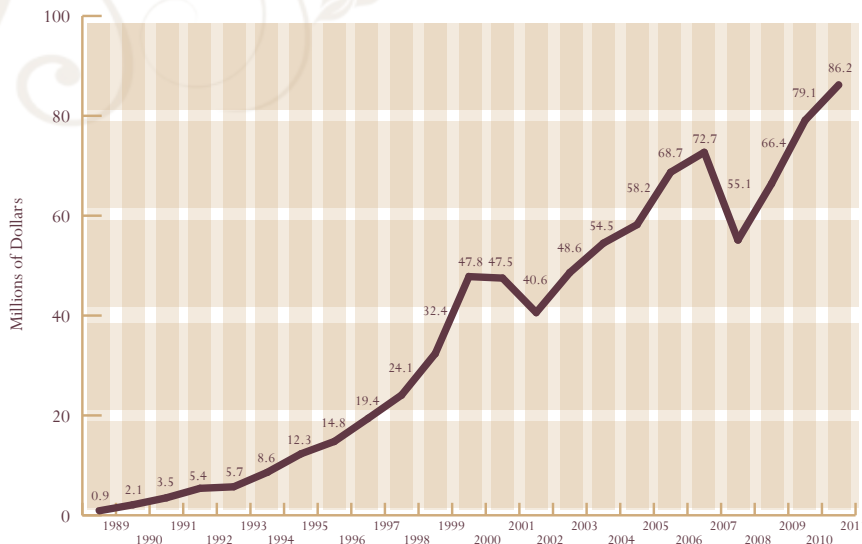

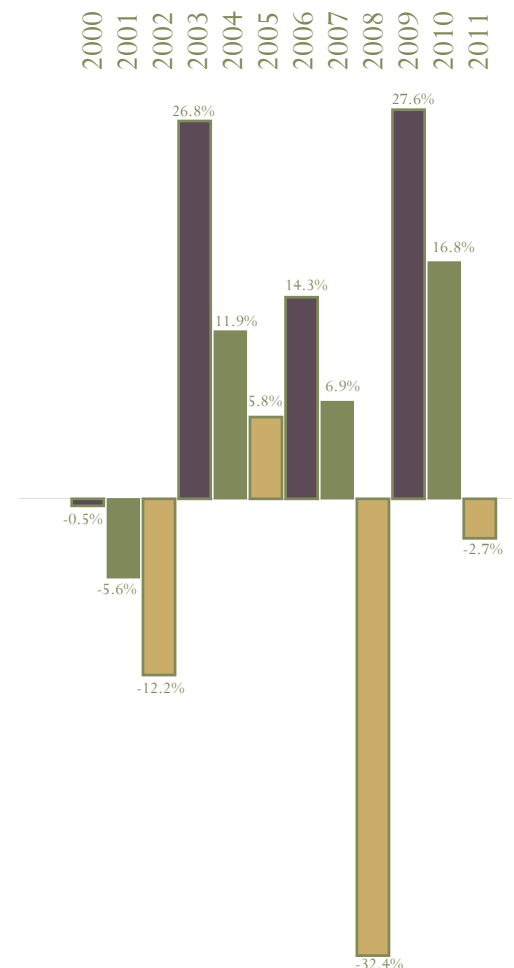
Managers are hired for specific investment assignments and in 2011 ICF retained the following managers for the equity portion of our portfolio:

1. Land for resale includes two non-cash contributions of property donated to the Foundation. The Foundation intends to sell the land and place the proceeds in specific funds according to the donation agreements. The value of the land recorded as an asset is equivalent to the county assessed values for 2011.
2. The Foundation accounts for its funds held as agency endowments in accordance with FASB Accounting Standards Codification Topic ASC 958 (previously Statement of Financial Accounting Standards No. 136). ASC 958 specifically requires that if a Not-For-Profit Organization (NPO) accepts cash or other financial assets from a donor, agrees to use those assets on behalf of or transfer those assets to establish a fund at a community foundation, and specifies itself as the beneficiary of that fund, the community foundation must account for the transfer of such asset as a liability. For financial reporting purposes, distributions from agency endowments in the amounts of \$297,397 in 2011 and \$299,249 in 2010 are not included in the reported Grants and Distributions of the Foundation.
3. Represents outstanding pledges less reserves.
4. Includes investment management fees of \$87,229 in 2011 and \$79,193 in 2010.

Donor Profile: Marcia Wing and Gregory Garlick



Marcia Wing learned about ICF in the late 1980s when the Foundation was first established. As a young woman just starting her career in property and casualty insurance, she

recalls that she didn't have any extra money at the time and that the Foundation's goal of a \$5 million endowment seemed out of reach.

"I had no idea then that the Foundation would achieve such amazing success, or that I would someday be in a position to create the funds that we have to honor both Greg's parents and my parents," she said.

Marcia and her husband Gregory Garlick established the Harry and Lisa Garlick Scholarship Fund in 2005 and the Alferd and Bethel Wing Fund in 2009. They have been ICF members since 2006. They are also members of the Legacy Society, which means they have included a gift to ICF in their estate planning.

ICF endowment funds appeal to Marcia and Greg because, as longtime Idahoans, they see the value in permanently supporting local nonprofits.

"I'm a big believer in permanent endowments," Marcia said. "My husband and I are not wealthy, but an organization like ICF allows people of relatively modest means to put money into funds that can make a difference in people's lives in perpetuity."

Growing up without much money on a small Idaho farm, Marcia knows the value of education, books and scholarships and said those are the areas she likes to support. "It was the generosity of others, such as the Whittenberger and Cunningham foundations, that allowed me to attend The College of Idaho, and I feel an obligation to repay their generosity by helping others who are in similar financial situations. Along the same vein, I grew up with books. Both of my parents were avid readers, and I cannot imagine how frustrating life must be for people who can't read, share books with their children, or even function at a basic level in most jobs. Learning Lab is one of my passions; seeing people develop their abilities to function in contemporary life and work toward breaking the family cycle of illiteracy is incredibly satisfying."

The Wilsons have two funds at ICF to support Reel Recovery – a philanthropic gift fund to provide scholarships for the summer retreats and an endowment fund so the program can become self-sustaining. They are also ICF members.

Staff is available to help you select a fund that will best accomplish your unique charitable goals.

Decide When

You can create your fund now or establish it as part of your estate. Tax deductions are realized at the time of the gift.

Decide How

Funds can be created with many different kinds of assets including: cash, checks or money orders; appreciated property (securities or real estate); tangible personal property (art or other collectables); private foundation transfer; bequests; qualified retirement plans; life insurance; and/or charitable gift annuity.

Execute A Fund Agreement

Work with ICF staff to draft and execute a fund agreement outlining your wishes and instructions.

Permanent funds to provide long-term support. Assets are invested and a small portion of the balance is available for annual distribution.

Advised

Fund Creator Profile: Marion L. and Lorena F. Shinn

Lifelong educator Marion Shinn and his wife Lorena Shinn established the Marion L. and Lorena F. Shinn Fund in 2011 to benefit the Nez Perce Historical Society in Lewiston.

"I want to support the historical society for the long-term and also create excitement for the future of the organization," said Marion, who has been on the board of directors of the historical society for more than 20 years and serves as its newsletter editor.

Designated funds like the Shinn Fund can be started with \$25,000, and provide annual support for one or more charitable organizations. Anyone can contribute to the fund, which is one of the reasons Marion started it.

"This is a place where someone can donate \$5 or any amount of money, and it will last forever," he said. "You can't say that with regular donations."

The Shinns, who are both 90 and have been married for 65 years, have been members of ICF since 2004. Marion said he likes providing support to ICF because it helps nonprofits throughout the state.

"ICF is an organization people should support for the overall good of every nonprofit in Idaho," he

said. "Only through a cooperative effort can we carry the dream of small nonprofits like the Nez Perce Historical Society."

Marion was raised on Doumecq Plains in Idaho County. There was no high school in the area in 1934, so he and his brother left home on horseback and moved into an apartment in Lewiston to attend school.

Lorena was raised in Bonners Ferry, and they met as students at Lewiston State Normal School, the teaching college that is now Lewis-Clark State College (LCSC).

After teaching in one-room schools for two years, Marion enlisted in the navy. He served in submarines overseas during WWII. He returned home four years later and married Lorena. He worked at Lewiston High School as a chemistry teacher and debate coach for 17 years. During the summers he was a park ranger at Glacier National Park. In 1965, he was named the first dean of the vocational educational program at LCSC. After he retired from LCSC, he was mayor of Lewiston and served on the city council.

Since retirement he and Lorena have remained active volunteers in several community organizations, traveled to more than 60 countries, and increased their focus on philanthropy.

"It was time to take some of the assets we'd accrued over the years and share them with the organizations whose work we have appreciated," he said. "We may not have the capital to invest with the big boys, so an ICF fund was perfect for our needs."

Fund Profile: Stanley School Hot Lunch Fund

Paul and Ann Hill first visited Stanley from Atlanta, Georgia in the late 1970s while on a river rafting vacation. Though they visited many Western cities over the summers that followed, they always felt a special connection to Stanley. When they decided to retire in 1999, they agreed that leaving Atlanta (population 750,000+) for Stanley (population 69) felt right.

Over the years, they have volunteered and become very active in a number of the area's non-profit community including the Stanley School, which serves the area's K through 8th grade students. “We get involved where there's a need,” Ann said. “There are few people in Stanley, so you end up wearing many hats.”

In 2008, the couple realized that the school, which has two teachers and normally serves between 10 and 20 students per year, didn't have a kitchen or other means to provide hot lunch. The Hills struck a deal with Shane Elisor and Melinda Hadzor, who own the BackCountry Bistro, to provide the students and teachers a hot lunch every Wednesday.

The Hills cover the cost of the program, which is free to students and teachers. The lunch program has been so well received that the Hills started an endowed ICF fund in 2011 designed to provide funding for the lunches in perpetuity. The fund will begin distributing once it reaches \$30,000, and will provide approximately \$1,500

per year toward the cost of lunches.

“Nutritious, hot lunches can make a huge difference in kids' ability to learn and it also says that this community cares about them and wants them to stay,” Paul said. “Like many rural communities, we have a real risk of young families leaving. In a community where fire and other emergency services are provided by volunteers, it's important to have young families in the area who can do those jobs and who share a real commitment to the community.”

The fund has received

support from a number of people in the Stanley area, including some very generous individual donors and groups like the the Sawtooth Mountain Mamas. “The kids all look forward to Wednesdays now and we hope this is a positive factor that encourages families to stay in Stanley,” Paul said.

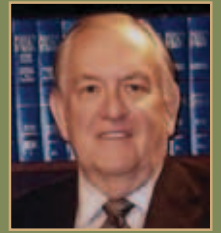
