<ul> <li>Graduating high school senior in Ada, Adams, Boise, Canyon, Elmore, Gem, Payette, Valley or Washington counties;</li> <li>OR graduating high school senior in Marsing, Homedale, Bruneau or Riggins;</li> <li>OR freshman or sophomore level college students attending the University of Idaho or Boise State University;</li> <li>Preference given to students attending or planning to attend University of Idaho or Boise State University;</li> <li>Idaho resident;</li> <li>Minimum 2.5 GPA;</li> <li>There is no financial need requirement.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Copy of your most recent unofficial high school transcript or college transcript. Non-traditional students that have not attended school recently must submit their last grade transcripts along with a history of employment.</li> <li>A written statement (1-3 pages in length) addressing the following: <ul> <li>Educational, career goals and objectives;</li> <li>Extra-curricular activities, volunteerism, awards, honors, and/or offices held;</li> <li>Work experience and if you plan to work while attending college;</li> <li>Why you should be selected for this scholarship;</li> </ul> </li> <li>Creative Writing Sample: <ul> <li>Choose ONE of the following three prompts and write a 300-word short story, news article, or opinion piece. Be creative and original.</li> <li>Is it preferable to have a few close friends or a wide variety of friends and do you think it is possible to have life-long friends?</li> <li>Does social media enhance or inhibit friendships?</li> <li>Describe a situation when a friend personally helped you or was there for you in a meaningful way.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Interview with Scholarship Committee (finalists will be contacted).</li> </ul>
