<ul> <li>Graduating high school senior in Ada, Adams, Boise, Canyon, Elmore, Gem, Payette, Valley or Washington counties;</li> <li>OR graduating high school senior in Marsing, Homedale, Bruneau or Riggins;</li> <li>OR freshman or sophomore level college students attending the University of Idaho or Boise State University;</li> <li>Preference given to students attending or planning to attend University of Idaho or Boise State University;</li> <li>Idaho resident;</li> <li>Minimum 2.5 GPA;</li> <li>There is no financial need requirement.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Copy of your most recent official high school transcript or college transcript. Non-traditional students that have not attended school recently must submit their last grade transcripts along with a history of employment.</li> <li>A written statement (1-3 pages in length) addressing the following: o Educational, career goals and objectives; o Extra-curricular activities, volunteerism, awards, honors, and/or offices held; o Work experience and if you plan to work while attending college; o Why you should be selected for this scholarship;</li> <li>Creative Writing Sample: Choose ONE of the following three prompts and write a 300-400 word short story, news article, or opinion piece. Be creative and original.  1) What keeps you up at night and why? 2) What is true and untrue for you regarding generalizations made about Gen Z's? 3) What is something about life or the world that is amazing and special but that most people do not notice. 4) Tell a funny story. 5) Describe a place you have traveled to, what it meant to you, what you learned, and why it was meaningful.</li> <li>Interview with Scholarship Committee (finalists will be contacted).</li> </ul>
