Joybelle Scott College Scholarship

Deadline: February 10th

Joybelle Scott was a teacher in Orofino Elementary School until she retired in 1987. To celebrate her life, Claire and Dow Scott established the Joybelle Scott College Scholarship Fund in the Idaho Community Foundation for deserving Orofino High School Seniors. A university education transformed Joybelle's life, enriching the lives of her four children and nine grandchildren. It is their sincere hope that the fund inspires and transforms the lives of young people from Orofino, enriching their lives and the lives of people around them.

AMOUNT AND USE:

One college scholarship will be awarded each year. The scholarship is for \$5,000 for the first college academic year and is renewable at \$5,000 for each of the following three years, if the student can show satisfactory progress towards a degree, for a total of \$20,000. Each year, the student's award is divided equally between the semesters or quarters of the academic institution the student is attending. The funds may cover tuition and other expenses directly related to obtaining a college education.

<u>Who Can Apply?</u>	<u>Required Application Materials</u>
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Graduating, college-bound Orofino High School students with financial need pursuing a college degree who can demonstrate an ability to do well in a college environment;• Minimum 3.0 GPA in the last 3½ years of high school, OR can demonstrate growth in academic achievement throughout their high school career;• Enrolled (or planning to enroll) in a full-time accredited college or university. The institution may or may not be in Idaho. Private for-profit universities and those affiliated with religion or a cult are excluded from this scholarship.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Copy of your most recent unofficial high school or college transcript;• A written statement (1-2 pages in length) describing the following:<ul style="list-style-type: none">o Why you would like to attend college;o How you expect to benefit from this experience;o How you expect to pay for college;• Two letters of recommendation.
