Both degree-seeking <i>and</i> certificate-seeking students are eligible.               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hospitality-related programs include (but are not limited to) hotel/lodging, culinary/restaurant, entertainment/golf club, resort, and the travel/tourism industries.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Awarded primarily on the basis of a student's desire for further education or training, and individual achievement as evidenced through participation in outside interests and activities, leadership roles and/or work experience.
