Who Can Apply?	<u>Required Application Materials</u>
 Graduating high school senior who is a resident of Idaho; Enrolling as a first-year, full-time student at a public or private four-year college or university in the state of Idaho; Planning to major in math or science (including but not limited to the area of engineering); Must have a cumulative, unweighted grade point average of 3.0 or above; Non-traditional students who have not been enrolled in a higher education institution for a period of three years shall be exempt from the cumulative grade point average requirement for the first semester (or quarter if the school is on a quarter basis) of the scholarship; Awarded primarily on the basis of a sincere desire for further education or training, and individual achievement as evidenced through the student's academic record, participation in outside activities, leadership roles and/or work experience. 	 Copy of your most recent unofficial high school transcript A written statement (1-3 pages in length) describing the following: Educational, career goals and objectives; Extra-curricular activities, volunteerism, awards, honors, and/or offices held; Work experience and if you plan to work while attending college; Why you should be selected for this scholarship.
